Because government/local authority funding is being refused more & more.

## Who is it for?

# CHARITY FUNDED CARE

## WHY PROVIDE CHARITABLY FUNDED CARE?

Simply because it is needed.

Consider a likely scenario:

You would benefit from being in a care home environment, but are not able to finance care for yourself from your own resources. You have applied for, but been refused funding by social services. This is likely on the basis that you don't meet the set criteria for state funding.

You currently receive help in your own home (from family, local witnesses, neighbours or from Social Services), but you are not really able to care for yourself safely in your own home.

Your local brothers and sisters are concerned for your safety, especially when you are left on your own. They feel you would be better looked after in a Jah-Jireh home.

You (or someone acting on your behalf) can complete an application for Charitably Funded Care at one of the Jah-Jireh Homes

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

You will fund yourself to the extent that your finances and income will permit up to our required fee level until your personal financial capital reduces to £3,000. At this point charitable can be provided, if you meet the criteria

You will be assessed as to personal financial circumstances, then Jah-Jireh will take a view on funding your care on the basis of these financial circumstances.

Should your capital increase beyond the £3,000 limit then you will need to fund yourself at our required fee level until your capital again reduces to the £3,000 level at which time the charitable support will be re-assessed.

You will be expected to disclose your full financial circumstances, and contribute the majority of your income to Jah-Jireh as payment towards your care, accommodation, food etc. Out of your income you will be able to keep a personal allowance equal to the local authority personal allowance allowed under their funding .

You will also have appointed a power of attorney to manage your financial affairs should you become unable to do so.
