Rene was then asked to go to Stow Market where she was given just two weeks to find some accommodation. Whenever Rene knocked on a door she would ask if they had a room to rent. On the last day, someone said 'yes' and offered Rene a tiny attic room. Rene knew that Jehovah had provided and that it was his will that she serve there where only she and one other sister made up the congregation.



At the visit of the Circuit Overseer, the two sisters conducted the entire meeting. This Circuit Overseer was Arthur Hewson who was to become Rene's



husband in 1954. They continued in the Circuit work together travelling all over the British Isles until ill health befell Rene in 1970's. the They then settled in Shef-

field where they continued to work hard in Jehovah's service.

In 1997 both Rene and Arthur moved in to the Radcliffe home. Rene's beloved Arthur died in September 2000 in the home.

Sadly, Rene died in the home on 16th December 2005. Rene never stopped thanking Jeho-

vah for giving her the opportunity to serve him. She felt she had been greatly blessed by him throughout all her years of service and enjoyed many, many faith strengthening experiences.
