A traditional pub was set up in one of the lounges, the bar was on loan from local suppliers and the room was complete with dart board, traditional drinks and even a local ale on tap. Memorabilia from traditional pubs complemented the atmosphere. There was also a sweet stall and some of our younger helpers dressed up and distributed these to the guests.

Another lounge was elegantly recreated as a ballroom where many took part in traditional dances. Last but not least our sun lounge recreated a cafe atmosphere and served afternoon tea before a tremendous spread buffet. Although the garden had been set up with a seaside theme, it was only briefly enjoyed by one of our younger guests.

Our residents were able to invite up to 4 guests each to join in the day, so it was a full house!

A big hello from Jah-Jireh in Beamsville, Ontario. A retirement home was opened here in 2001 and is able to care for 35 residents depending on their needs. Spiritual activities such as Bible reading, Watchtower study preparation and field ministry arrangements are all available within the home. One sister from a nearby congregation has been volunteering for over 15 years doing physical therapy and exercise with the residents.

When asking one resident for an evaluation of her care at Jah-Jireh: "If I was to give it marks out of 10, my answer would be 20."
