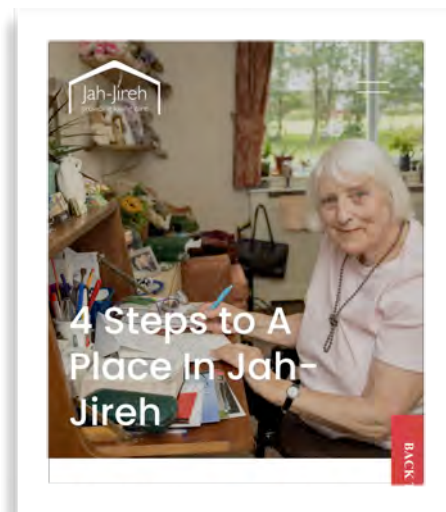
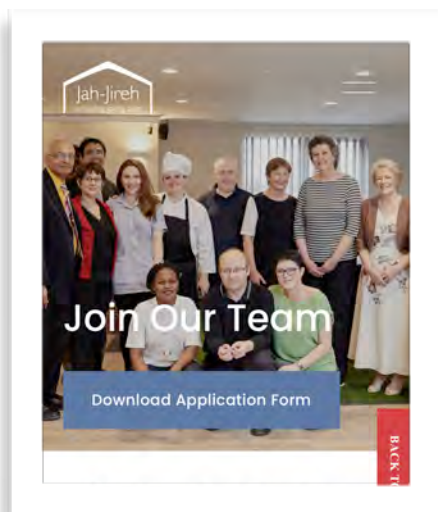


Website Launch!
